Donning and Doffing Tips for your Jacwaders:

On: Place each foot in a boot, roll the legs up to the waist by pulling upward on the thigh are material. The idea is to get them on up to your waist, first. Take caution not to initially pull upward from chest area. This will put undue strain on the neoprene seams. Then, simply reach back and put one arm in and follow with the other arm. Zip up and you are set to go!

Jacwaders can be vented as need at the chest zipper section. Another tip is to remove your arms from the suit, bring the arms around to the front and using the Velcro wrist straps, and attach the arms together. This will allow for ventilation when exerting extra effort (i.e. Decoy set-up)

Off: Unzip arms out, roll down to leave the boot top openings exposed.

Note: Jacwaders can be turned inside out to rid any moisture from the inside to dry.

Jacwaders are warranted by the manufacturer for one (1) year from the day of purchase against defects in materials or workmanship. Please send in the enclosed warranty card within thirty (30) days.
